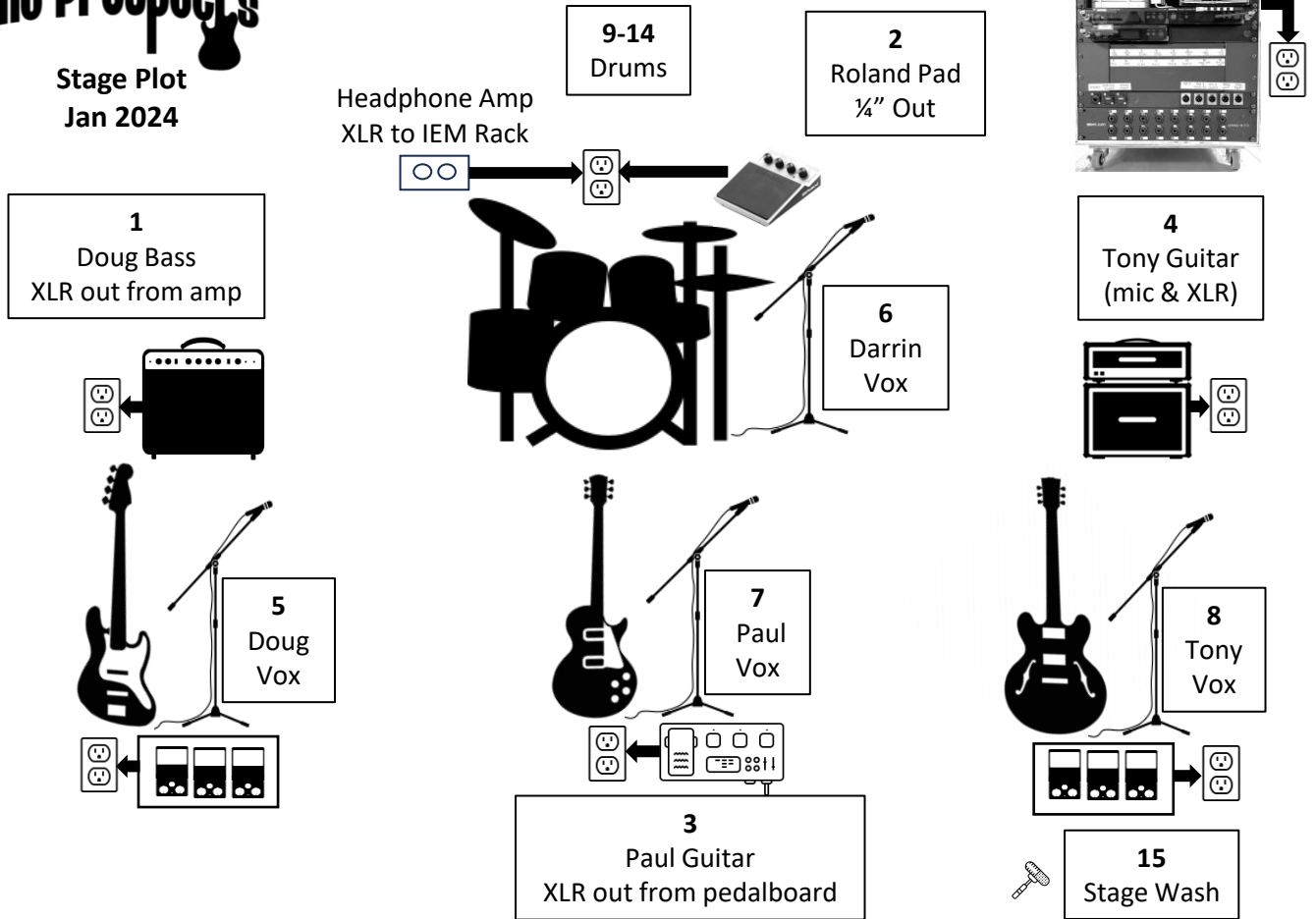

Notes for Sound Engineer

- All items go to front of IEM Rack/Splitter Snake first per input list. Tail of snake is not numbered but all instruments/vox are marked on tail. Connect in whatever order is needed on your end.
- No monitors/wedges needed. We are all IEM.
- Doug, Paul and Tony are wireless IEM, Darrin will need an XLR cable to his headphone amp.
- Band will supply their own vocal mics. All members use Sennheiser e945. Need four boom stands.
- Band supplies stage wash mic. No stand needed. Run a XLR to Tony's mic stand for stage wash mic.
- If you want to use a talk back, we have a wireless mic for your use or we can unplug 16 from our mixer and you plug your mic into 16. Let Tony know.
- Mix Paul's guitar low. Sometimes he is strumming but he mutes himself. He does it to keep time.
- Drum pad is used throughout the night for auxiliary percussion and an effect or two (depending on song.)
